



The Debtors wish to maintain their policy with Columbia Casualty Insurance Company until January 15, 2009 (the “Termination Date”), and may maintain the policy beyond that date for a specific number of days if on or before January 15, 2009, the Debtors shall have paid AICCO an additional amount equal to \$146.81 times the number of days by which the January 15, 2009 termination date is to be extended. The Debtors may repeat the process of an extension of the termination date by payment to AICCO – on or before the extended termination date – of \$146.81 per day for the number of days by which the deadline is to be extended, but may repeat the extension process only once. If, by the date immediately after the Termination Date – or the date immediately after the date to which the Termination Date shall have been extended in accordance with the provisions above – AICCO shall not have received from the Debtors a payment to extend the Termination Date, the automatic stay shall be terminated as to AICCO as of that date without further order of the Court, and AICCO shall be authorized to cancel the policy on that date, collect the unearned premiums under the policy, and apply the premiums in reduction of the Debtors’ debt to AICCO. It is, therefore:

ORDERED that AICCO, Inc.’s Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay and Adequate Protection be, and hereby is, GRANTED with respect to the three (3) policies with Travelers Casualty & Surety Company and policy with Federal Insurance Company so as to allow AICCO to immediately cancel the policies by AICCO, collect the unearned premiums under the policy, and apply the premiums in reduction of the Debtors’ debt to AICCO; and it is further

ORDERED that on January 7, 2009, Debtors shall tender payment in the amount of \$6,312.83 to AICCO, Inc. as payment for post-petition insurance premiums on their Columbia Casualty Company policy from the period of December 4, 2008 through January 15, 2009, and if that payment is not timely received, the automatic stay shall be terminated as to AICCO with

respect to the Columbia Casualty policy as of January 7, 2009, without further order of the Court to allow AICCO to cancel the policy on that date, collect the unearned premiums under the policy, and apply the premiums in reduction of the Debtors' debt to AICCO. Debtors shall make the January 7, 2009 payment and any subsequent payment by wire transfer to JP Morgan Chase.
