

ORDERED that the procedures outlined in the Motion to provide adequate assurance of payment of services is sufficient to preclude unilateral termination under 11 U.S.C. § 366(b) and provides adequate protection pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362; and it is further

ORDERED that pending a final herein upon the Motion, the Utilities described in the Motion are prohibited from unilaterally altering, refusing or discontinuing service to the Debtors so long as the Debtors are in compliance with the procedures and requirements set forth in the Motion and approved on an interim basis herein; and it is further

ORDERED that nothing herein shall prohibit any Utility from requesting, at a later point, after notice and opportunity for hearing, additional and/or different adequate protection under 11 U.S.C. § 362 and/or adequate assurance of payment under 11 U.S.C. § 366(b); and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is entered on an interim basis and shall come on for final hearing at 1:30 o'clock on January 12, 2009; and it is further

ORDERED that objections to the entry of a final order shall be filed and served on Debtor's counsel, Patricia B. Tomasco, on or before 1-9, 2009, at BROWN MCCARROLL L.L.P., 111 Congress Avenue, Suite 1400, Austin, Texas 78701 (512) 226-7324 (fax); and it is further

ORDERED that Debtors shall be responsible for notice, and shall serve all parties subject to this Motion immediately upon entry.
